You will need 137 - 3" fractured hexagon blocks from *The New Hexagon Perpetual Calendar*, plus 612 - 3" Irregular Hexagon Paper Pieces (IRREGHEX300). English Paper Piece the quilt center, including the 'empty' outside links. Cut border fabrics about 13" wide and slide under the outside 'empty' links, so that there is about 1/2" overlap. Appliqué in place. The 60 degree angles in the border were appliquéd in place. Trim as necessary to square up quilt top.

The melding together of the light and dark connectors, and the compilation of varied, dissimilar blocks, which fill the connectors, represent my wish that as human beings we could all live in harmony, respecting our differences. The ring of empty links around the outside edges represent connections not yet made.

Top piecing by me, blocks by many, all connected to me through my quilting life.
