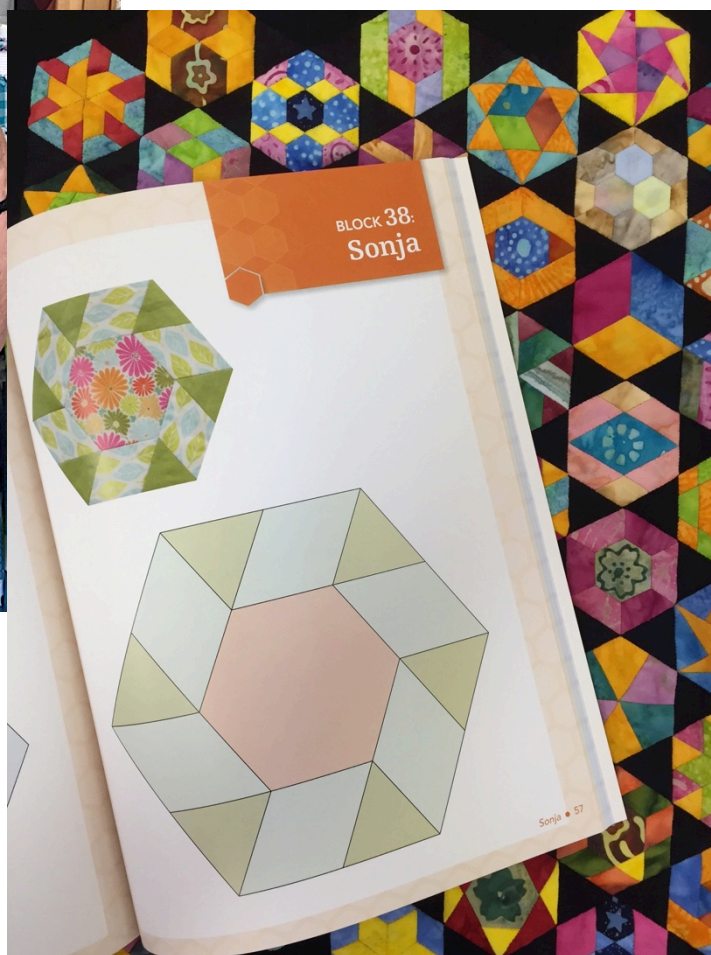

Each block is 1" along the edge. I've shown a comparison to the 3" blocks from the book below. (The blocks diagram is 3" along the edge). The smallest piece is a  $\frac{1}{3}$ " equilateral triangle.

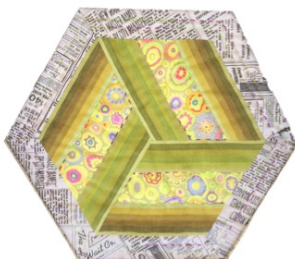
