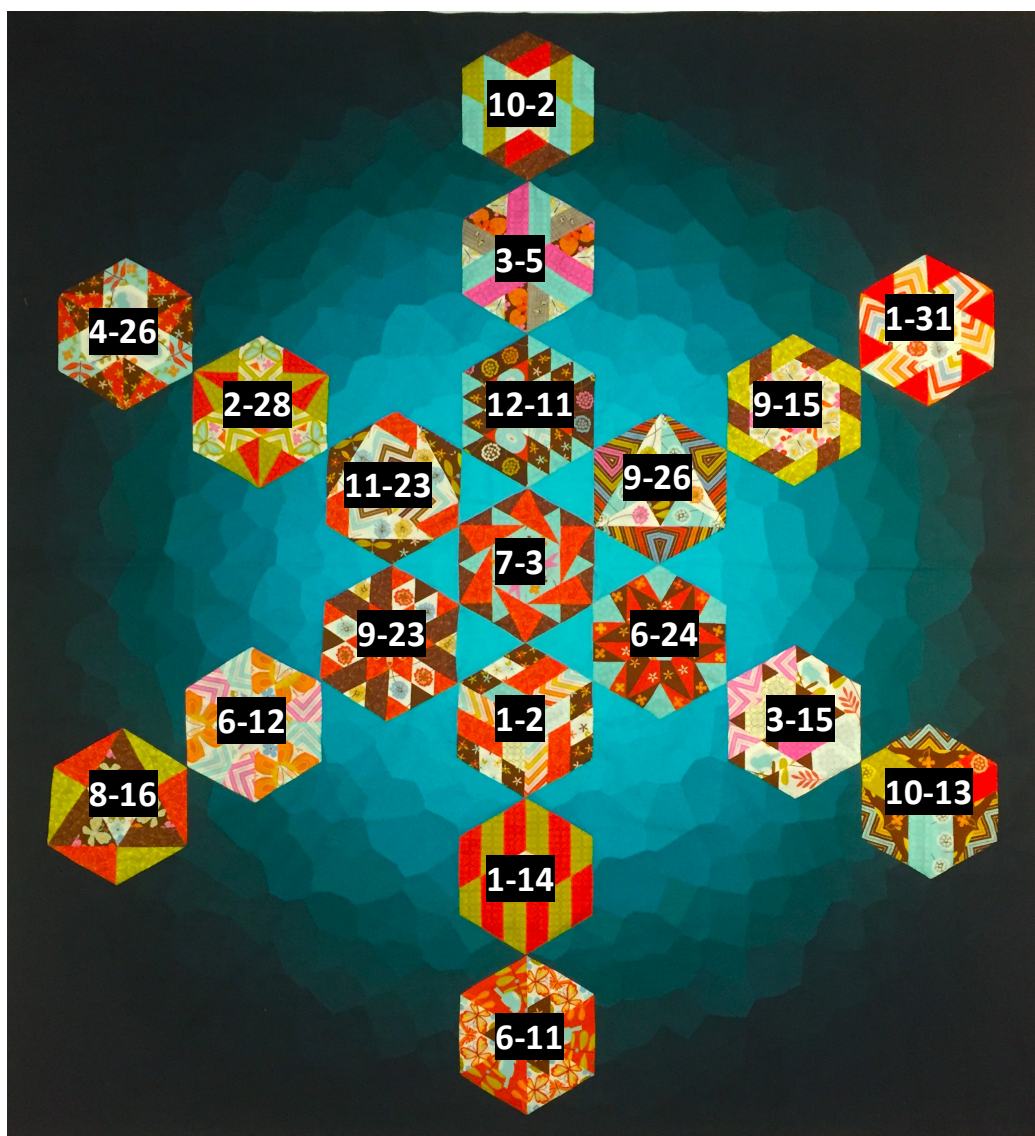
Size: 39 1/2" x 43"



Uses 19 Blocks from *The New Hexagon Perpetual Calendar*

The sample was made with 3" finished hexagon blocks and the Super Nova fabric panels from Hoffman California fabrics as background.

Find the center of the panel and appliqué one 3" hexagon block. Placing the hexagon blocks point-to-point, appliqué 3 more hexagon blocks next to each point of the center hexagon, ensuring the angles between the arms of the star are 60 degrees.
